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

Senior Center Board Report for October 2014

Meals: 788 meals were served to 157 attendees.

<u>Transportation</u>: 488 one way trips were provided to 89 participants.

ESP Medical: There were 21 units for 6 clients.

Adult Day Care: There were a total of 148 trips provided for 5 clients.

Home Meals: There were 2794 home meals delivered to 105 clients.

Supportive Services: There were 53 units for 23 clients.

<u>Socialization/Recreation</u>: There were 106 different activities and 251 clients attending.

Homemaking Services: 797 hours for 114 clients.

Total transportation miles: We traveled 8486 miles transporting cli-

ents.

<u>Total miles delivering meals</u>: We traveled 3638 miles delivering meals.


