

RECIPIE OF THE MONTH

Chile-Cheese Stuffed Mushrooms

Ingredients

Cooking spray 24 medium button mushrooms (about 1 pound), stems discarded 1 4-ounce can chopped green chilies, drained

Preparation

- 1. Preheat the oven to 400°F. Line a baking sheet with aluminum foil.
- 2. Place the mushrooms with the stem side down on the foil. Lightly spray the mushrooms with cooking spray.
- 3. Bake for 10 minutes.
- 4. Transfer the baking sheet to a cooling rack. Turn the mushrooms over. Fill each with the chilies. Sprinkle with the Cheddar.

Bake for 5 minutes, or until the Cheddar is melted. Remove from the oven and let stand for 3 minutes so the flavors blend.
