Senior Center Board Report for February 2015

Meals: 382 meals were served to 75 attendees.

Transportation: 436 one way trips were provided to 71 participants.

ESP Medical: There were 12 units for 4 clients.

<u>Adult Day Care</u>: There were a total of 94 trips provided for 7 clients.

Home Meals: There were 1655 home meals delivered to 68 clients.

Supportive Services: There were 91 units for 31 clients.

<u>Socialization/Recreation</u>: There were 88 different activities and 229 clients attending.

Homemaking Services: 722.25 units for 118 clients.

<u>Total transportation miles</u>: We traveled 6330 miles transporting clients.

<u>Total miles delivering meals</u>: We traveled 2713 miles delivering meals.


