Senior Center Board Report for August 2015

Meals: 533 meals were served to 112 attendees.

Transportation: 330 one way trips were provided to 50 participants.

ESP Medical: There were 17 units for 6 clients.

Adult Day Care: There were a total of 81.5 trips provided for 6 cli-

ents.

Home Meals: There were 1801 home meals delivered to 71 clients.

Supportive Services: There were 44.50 units for 18 clients.

<u>Socialization/Recreation</u>: There were 130.50 different activities and 186 clients attending.

Homemaking Services: 947units for 133 clients.

<u>Total transportation miles</u>: We traveled 10514 miles transporting clients.

<u>Total miles delivering meals</u>: We traveled 3021 miles delivering meals.

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

September supplies:

Low-Fat Banana Bread

3 Cups all-purpose flour (or 2 cups white and 1 cup whole-wheat)

- 1 1/2 Cups sugar
- 2 ½ tsp. Baking Powder
- 1 tsp. Baking Soda
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 4 egg whites
- 4 small or 3 larger mashed bananas
- ½ cup unsweetened applesauce

Directions:

- 1. In one bowl, combine egg whites, bananas and applesauce.
- 2. In another larger bowl, stir flour, sugar, powder, soda, and cinnamon.
- 3. Add the wet bowl to the dry bowl and stir until just combined. If thick, add TBS. hot water
- 4. Pour batter into a greased 8 inch X 4 inch bread pan and bake 45-55 minutes at 350 degrees. Cool on a wire rack.


