Strawberry Dream Squares

12 graham crackers, finely crushed (about 2 cups)

1/3 cup margarine, melted

1-8 oz. cream cheese, softened

1/4 cup sugar

1 cup drained mashed thawed frozen strawberries

3 cups thawed whipped topping, divided

2 pkgs. (3.4 oz. each) vanilla instant pudding

3-1/2 cups cold milk

Mix graham crackers and margarine. Reserve 2 tbsp. crumb mixture; press remaining onto bottom of 13x9-inch pan. Refrigerate while preparing filling.

Mix cream cheese and sugar in medium bowl until blended. Add strawberries; mix well. Gently stir in 2 cups whipped topping; spread over crust. Beat pudding mixes and milk with whisk 2 minutes; pout over cream cheese layer. Refrigerate 1 hour; top with remaining whipped topping and reserved crumb mixture. Refrigerate 4 hours.
